To establish such service centres, programmes and facilities as will enable the Trustees to provide appropriate community social services.

To alleviate the difficulties of those experiencing hardships of whatever kind, including financial hardship and to bring relief through whatever means are available.

To initiate, establish, and administer community and social services for people of all ages who for any reason are in need of care, counselling or assistance.

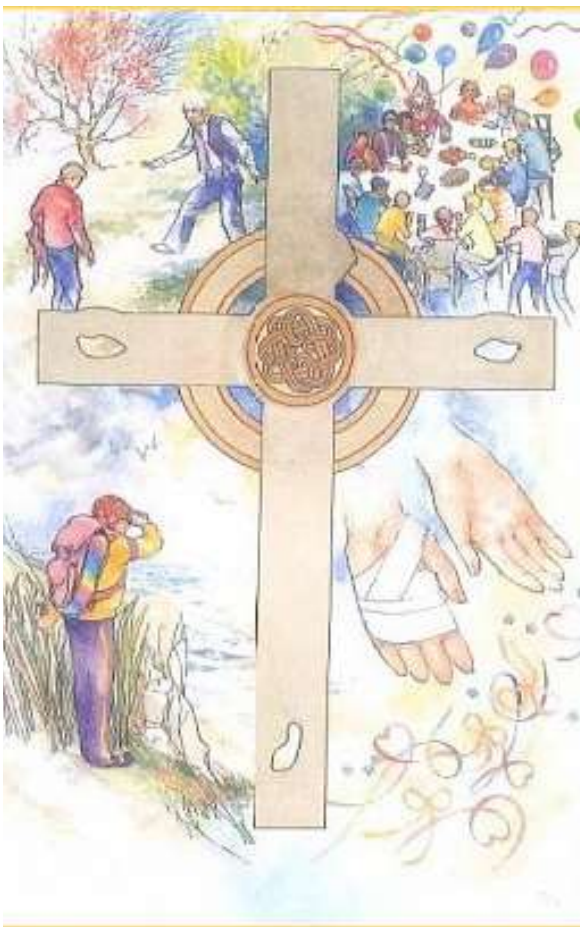
